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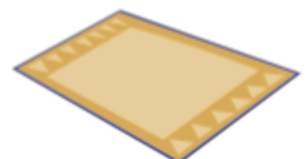
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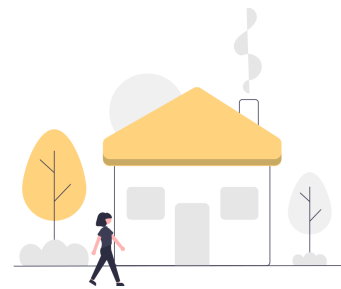

Use	Used with a singular noun	Used with a plural noun
Example	There is a pillow on the bed. There is a bed in the bedroom. There is a lamp on the table.	There are window <u>s</u> in the room. There are pillow <u>s</u> on the bed. There are blanket <u>s</u> on the bed.

Example	There isn't a pillow on the bed. There isn't a bed in the bedroom. There isn't a lamp on the table.	There aren't any window <u>s</u> in the room. There aren't any pillow <u>s</u> on the bed. There aren't any blanket <u>s</u> on the bed.



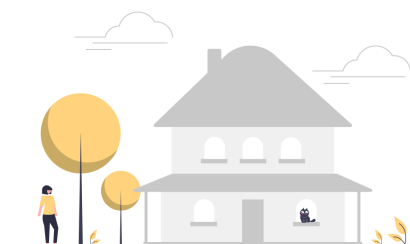
Note	We use any when talking about a plural noun that does not exist.
Example	There aren't any curtains in the bedroom.
