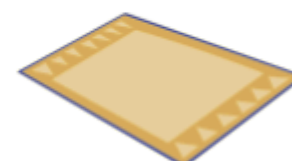

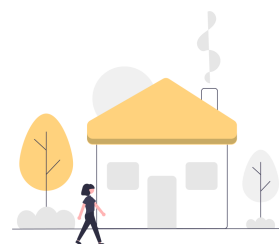

<b>We use <i>there is / there are</i> to say that something does or doesn't exist.</b>

	<b>There is</b>	<b>There are</b>
<b>Use</b>	<b>Used with a singular noun</b>	<b>Used with a plural noun</b>
<b>Example</b>	<p>There <b>is</b> a pillow on the bed.</p> <p>There <b>is</b> a bed in the bedroom.</p> <p>There <b>is</b> a lamp on the table.</p>	<p>There <b>are</b> window<u>s</u> in the room.</p> <p>There <b>are</b> pillow<u>s</u> on the bed.</p> <p>There <b>are</b> blanket<u>s</u> on the bed.</p>
-		
<b>Example</b>	<p>There <b>isn't</b> a pillow on the bed.</p> <p>There <b>isn't</b> a bed in the bedroom.</p> <p>There <b>isn't</b> a lamp on the table.</p>	<p>There <b>aren't any</b> window<u>s</u> in the room.</p> <p>There <b>aren't any</b> pillow<u>s</u> on the bed.</p> <p>There <b>aren't any</b> blanket<u>s</u> on the bed.</p>



**Note** We use **any** when talking about a plural noun that does not exist.

**Example** There aren't **any** curtains in the bedroom.

### Contractions

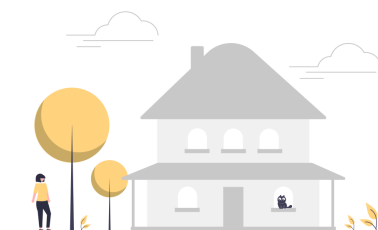
is not = isn't

are not = aren't
