3 FATHER'S DAY

Father's Day is a special day to celebrate our dads. It is a time to show how much we love and appreciate them. Father's Day is celebrated in many countries around the world. In the UK, it is celebrated on the third Sunday of June.

On this day, children give their fathers cards, gifts, and spend time with them. Some popular gifts include ties, mugs, or tools. Some children also make breakfast for their fathers or take them out for a meal.

Many people believe that the idea of Father's Day started in the United States. In 1910, a woman named Sonora Smart Dodd wanted to honour her father. Her father, William Smart, was a single parent who raised six children by himself.

Sonora thought that fathers should also have a special day, just like mothers do on Mother's Day. So, she began a campaign to make Father's Day a holiday. The first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910.

In the UK, Father's Day is not a public holiday. This means that people still go to work, and schools are open. However, many families still find time to celebrate. Some families go out for a picnic, or have a barbecue in the garden. Others go for a walk in the park or watch a film together at home.

Father's Day is a time to remember not only our fathers but also other important men in our lives. This could be a stepfather, grandfather, uncle, or family friend. It is a day to say "thank you" for all the things they do for us.

Even though Father's Day is only once a year, it is important to show our fathers that we love and care for them every day. Father's Day is a wonderful opportunity to make our fathers feel appreciated. It is a day filled with love, gratitude, and joy.

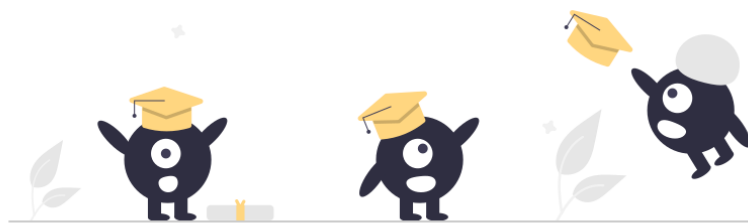
