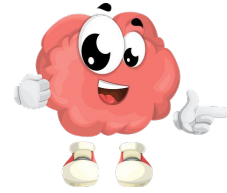
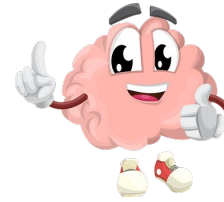


City Pets

For people in cities, pets that do not need a lot of space are the best. The right pets for a city must be okay with spending a lot of time indoors.

One popular city pet is a cat. Cats do well in smaller living spaces, like apartments. Cats do not need a lot of things to live. They only need a litter box, food, and water.

Small rodents like hamsters, gerbils, and mice are great city pets. They do not need a lot of space. You do not need to take them outside for exercise, like a dog.

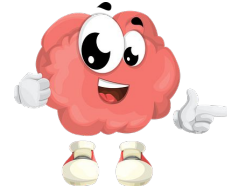
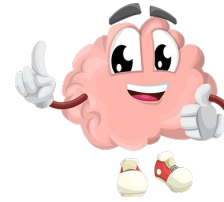

People in the countryside might live near farms, hills, and fields. This is great for pets, like big dogs, that need a lot of exercise.

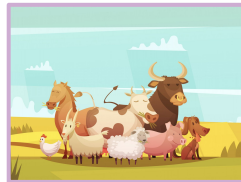
Livestock such as horses, cows, goats, and chickens are common in the countryside. These animals make great countryside pets. They can also provide food.

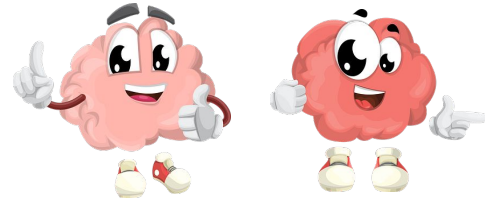




Board Game
