1 THEORY

Study the tables below.

Superlative adjectives are used to describe a quality as the 'most' or the 'least'

- "est" to the end of the word.
- "most" before the word.

Superlatives	
One syllable.	<p>Add "est" to the word</p> <p>Fast ---> Fastest Slow ---> Slowest</p>
Two syllables ending in consonant + "y".	<p>"Y" ----- > "iest"</p> <p>Heavy --- > Heaviest Early --- > Earliest</p>
Two or more syllables.	<p>Add "most" before the word.</p> <p>Dangerous --- > Most dangerous.</p>
Irregular.	<p>Bad --- > Worst</p> <p>Good --- > Best</p> <p>Far --- > Furthest</p>
